Jill Rosenberry's Story

Jill was 4½ years old when she was diagnosed with a very rare form of T-Cell Lymphoma cancer (mature cells) in September 2007.



According to the doctors she probably had this since mid August 2007. The cancer was in the marrow but was not present in any organs, spinal fluid or cerebellum. She successfully completed 4 months of aggressive chemotherapy, 6 treatments of radiation (full body) followed by a complete bone marrow transplant in January 2008. She left Nationwide Children's Hospital in March 2008 to complete her recovery at home.

In February 2010 Jill relapsed with the same cancer. This time it appeared in her left femur and hip areas. She is scheduled for 6 rounds of chemotherapy and is in between rounds 3 and 4 of chemo. Jill is now 7 years old.

I first met Jill and her family 4 years ago at the barn we have our horse. Their son Jimmy was taking horseback riding lessons. Over time a friendship was formed. In May of this year I approached Jill's father and asked if I could do something for his family. He was very humble and accepted. This story touched my heart because not only is this family going through a difficult time with Jill, but Jill's mother has gone through breast cancer twice since January 2008.

Brenda Rosenberry was diagnosed with stage 2 breast cancer in January 2008 while Jill was in the bone marrow transplant ward on J5 at Children's Hospital. She had 4 months of chemotherapy and surgery. She relapsed in the summer of 2009 with two more lumps and had surgery again followed by 31 radiation treatments that ended in January 2010.
